Lord, Lord Shinwell, referred—an uncommitted Reserve.

My noble friend asked me about uniforms. Certainly it is our aim to provide the new units with their uniforms as soon as possible, but I hope he will appreciate that there are some administrative difficulties about this. However, we shall do what we can.

Lastly, he asked me whether it would be possible for there to be some practice of rapid reinforcement exercises to Germany—for example, that one unit or another might fly out for the week-end. This is an interesting idea, because I am sure that reinforcement is one of the most important problems that we have to face.

I should like to look at the suggestion my noble friend has made, and I will communicate with him later on.
