THE NATO joint exercise Strong Express will be held throughout the Northern Atlantic area from 14th to 28th September. The last exercise of similar scope was "Silver Tower" conducted in 1968.

Strong Express is a large land, sea and air exercise which will involve about 64,000 men, 300 ships and 700 aircraft, and will be conducted jointly by the three major NATO military commanders: Admiral C. K. Duncan (USN), Admiral Sir Edward Ashmore (RN), and General A. Goodpaster (USA).
